PA CATHOLIC CONFERENCE

Is asking for your help. This month the State Senate is considering legislation that would change state law to allow survivors of childhood sexual abuse from decades ago to file lawsuits against private institutions like the Catholic Church, parishes like this one, schools & ministries. This legislation will severely damage the ministries of the Catholic community in Pennsylvania. Public institutions, such as public schools, where the vast majority of abuse cases occur, would not face lawsuits from the past, under this law. Sexual abuse is a serious crime that affects every institution & community in Pennsylvania, public & private. Because of its gravity, it needs to be dealt with comprehensively & fairly going forward.
