TWENTY-SECOND ORDINARY SUNDAY

Faithful obedience to God's law is a sign of our love and devotion to Him.

It might seem to some that obedience to God's law restricts their lives and their freedom. Yet viewed in terms of a human analogy, we know that when parents call their children to be obedient, they do so out of a sense of loving responsibility. Parents are charged to guide their children to become capable and faithful adults. In the same way, God's law directs us in our spiritual relationship with Him.
